

Fusion Okey Dokey

Buzzers are one of the main food sources for trout.

This is a twist on the original 'Okey Dokey' using Flybox Fusion Threads.



Dressing

Hook	Buzzer / Grub Size 10 – 16	Thorax	Flybox Mosaic Orange Fusion Thread
Thread	Fusion Threads	Hackle	None
Body	Flybox Pearl Fusion Thread	Head	Whip finish and varnish or Bug Bond
Rib	None		



Step 1

Set hook in vice (ping it) and run on Pearl Fusion tying thread.



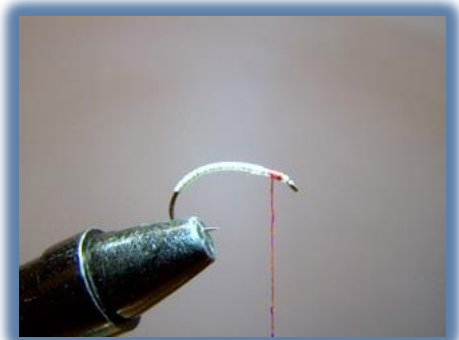
Step 2

Wind Pearl Fusion thread down hook shank around bend and return back up to thorax area.



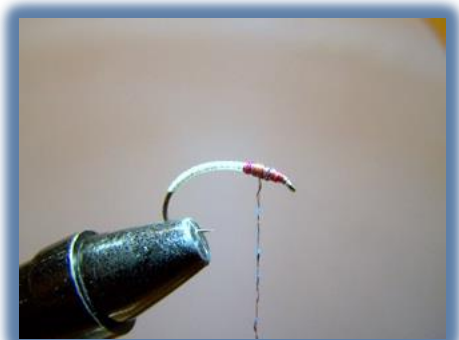
Step 3

Whip finish and remove thread.



Step 4

Catch on Mosaic Orange Fusion thread and remove excess.



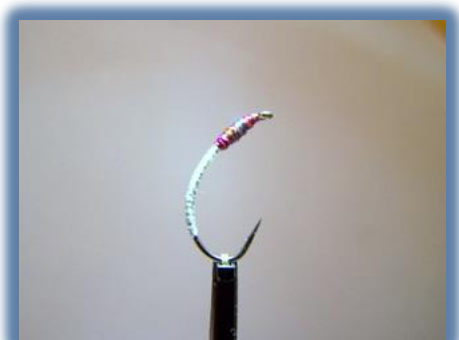
Step 5

Build up thorax area.



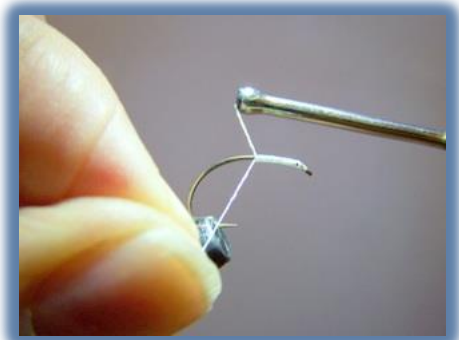
Step 6

Whip finish and remove thread.



Step 7

Coat whole fly with Bug Bond or 2-3 coats of varnish.



Tip

Use excess thread to help guide the thread down the hook shank then remove excess before returning up the hook shank towards eye.
